## PSA 2023/2024 Interclub Competition:

The NBPS club competes with approximately 25 clubs from around the world in the competition. Two years ago, the NBPS club won 1st place in our category, so we were moved up to a higher-level of competition. There will be 2 more rounds of competition in February and April. This year instead of having a committee select what images are submitted for each competition, any member that wishes to participate can submit images. The images will be submitted for the competition based on the sequence they were received by Carol. If there are not enough images submitted to meet the total allowed for each round, she will select additional images from the prior monthly assignments. Deadline for the February round is January 12, 2024. Color and B&W categories.

#### NBPS Youth Photo Competition:

The Greater New Braunfels Arts Council (GNBAC) sponsors the annual youth competition and the NBPS club chairs and runs the contest. Although the NBPS is a nonprofit organization it is not a tax-deductible organization. The GNBAC is a tax-deductible nonprofit organization whose membership is made up of both nonprofit and for-profit organizations. The GNBAC provides the basic funds needed for the Youth Photo contest and additional donations are solicited from the public. The donations made by businesses and individuals toward the contest are tax-deductible.

The contest is open to any high school or middle school student in the area, whether attending public, private, or home schooling. The Youth contest will use the same forms and categories as the PSA Youth Contest. Submissions for the contest will be digital this year, submission by February 1, 2024. Installation of photos at the Convention Center February 26, 2024. Victor is asking the sponsors to print the winning images at no cost to the student so they can be displayed for 2 weeks at the NB Convention Center. The awards ceremony will be held at the convention center March 16, 2024.

## **PSA Youth Competition:**

In addition to the NBPS Youth Photo Competition the New Braunfels High School and Piper High Schools have been invited to participate in the PSA Youth Contest. Six images from each school will be submitted to the PSA Youth Competition. PSA Deadline is April 12. 2024
