MILKY WAY WORKSHOP IN FORT GRIFFIN By Jackies Wise

On July 25–26, 2025, I had the privilege of attending the Night Skies at Ft. Griffin photography workshop alongside Christane, Sharlana, Suki, Tiffany, and myself—five curious creatives chasing stars and stories across the rugged beauty of North Texas. Led by the talented instructors David Begis and Delania Truly, the workshop was a masterclass in astrophotography, blending technical depth with soulful inspiration. Set at one of the dark sky locations in Texas, the experience offered a rare chance to capture the Milky Way, star trails, and light-painted landscapes with clarity and intention.

David and Delania guided us through every step—from gear setup and low-light focusing to composing dramatic foregrounds using the ruins of the historic fort and the silhouettes of the Texas State Longhorn Herd. Their instruction was hands-on and encouraging, tailored to each participant's skill level. The pre- and post-workshop Zoom sessions added thoughtful structure, helping us prepare beforehand and refine our edits afterward with confidence.

Just when we thought the weekend couldn't get any richer, an unexpected moment of connection opened the door to something extraordinary. On my way to the initial sync-up at the workshop site, a park ranger approached me, curious about our gathering. After learning about our interest in photography, he asked if we might be interested in learning about the longhorns—and that simple exchange turned into a once-in-a-lifetime experience. By Sunday morning, he had arranged a private tour of the state longhorn ranch just for our group.


We were invited to feed the herd, walk among them, and take hundreds of candid photos—face to face with these majestic animals in the golden morning light. The ranger's generosity and enthusiasm transformed a casual conversation into something deeply memorable. It was a powerful reminder: stay open to opportunity, never close yourself off from connection. Sometimes, the best stories begin with a question.

Whether you're chasing stars or seeking soulful moments under wide Texas skies, this workshop delivered both technical mastery and emotional resonance. I left with images I'm proud of—and memories that feel timeless.



GNBPC Annual Dues

Hello everyone - just a friendly reminder that you can renew your annual membership between October 2025 and February 2026.

Annual dues shall be assessed on a calendar year basis as follows:

\$40 per person or \$60 per family (i.e., where family is defined as persons living within the same household); \$20 per person or \$30 per family if joining after June 30; \$40 per person or \$60 per family if joining after October 30 and shall extend to the following year (maximum of 14 months); or

\$20 for persons under the age of 18, or persons enrolled in full-time high school or college.

Dues are payable by the February meeting to be a member in good standing.


